

Student Drop-Off and Pick-up for Activities, Spectator/Parent Parking for After School Events

Length – Majority of Construction of New Building (likely through 2028)

Student Drop-off and Pick-up for Field Trips and out-of-town Extra-or-Co-Curricular Activities

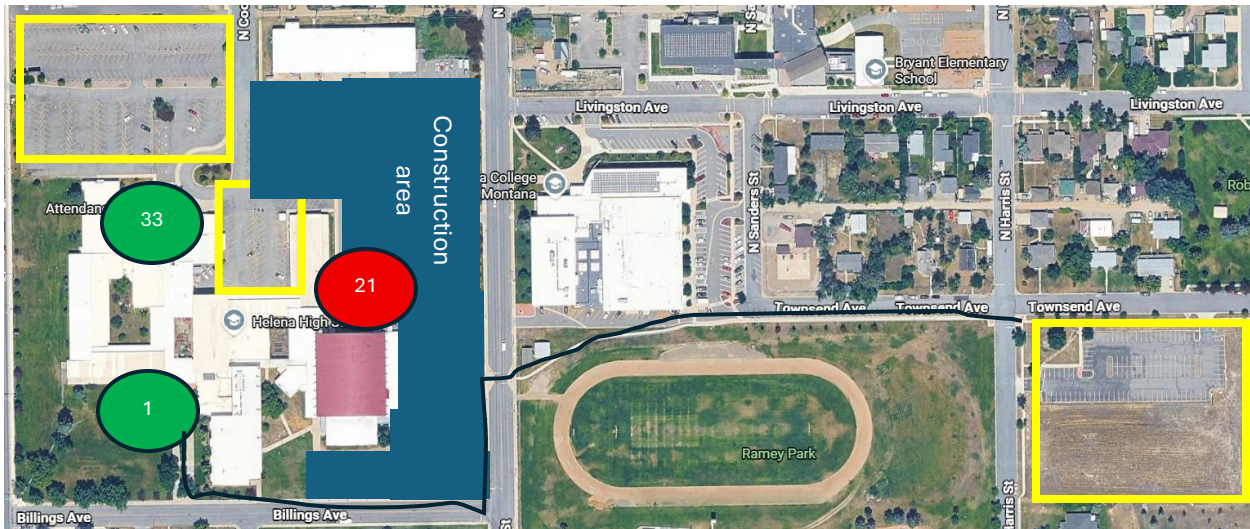
This information will pertain to student drop-off and pick-up when they are going on a Field Trip, out-of-town for a game or other school-related event (can be overnight or a same-day event).

- Busses will pick students up on Billings Avenue.
 - If your student needs to leave early, please have them bring their travel bag and other belongings directly into the main building at the start of the day. Generally, we cannot adjust early dismissal times for students to walk back to the Harris Street Temporary School Parking Lot to retrieve items, and we need to ensure buses depart on time.
- As a reminder, Billings Avenue will serve as a bus loading zone and Emergency Vehicle zone. Students, parents, and coaches will not be allowed to park in that area to wait for a bus.
- If this is for a class field trip, the bus will drop off again on Billings Avenue and students can enter the building and disperse from there.
- If this is for an out-of-town game or other event, the bus will make its first drop at the Harris Street Temporary School Parking Lot for students who have parked out there. It will then come and drop back off on Billings Avenue for students who are waiting for parents or were able to get a parking spot at the school that day.
 - If you are travelling on a weekend, we encourage all students to park at the school so that only one drop off location is needed.
 - Students will need to bring all their school stuff with them on the bus as well if they are parked in the Harris Street Temporary School Parking Lot.
 - Parents can pick up their child on the south side of Billings Avenue or at the Harris Street Lot.

Spectator Parking for After-School Events (Games, Plays, Open House, etc.)

Events in the Building

- Parking will be available on the north side of the building for spectators/attendees. The preferred entry for events will be through Entry 33 on the north side of the building.
- If that lot is full, spectators will be able to park at the Harris Street Temporary School Parking Lot and walk over to the building. Entry 1 will be open for people to come in as well.
- Entry 21 – the entry you are likely used to coming in for games or activities is an Emergency Exit only throughout construction. You will no longer be able to use this entry.
- Billings Avenue will have minimal parking on the south side of the street. Parking will not be available in the bus loading and Emergency Vehicle Zone on the north side of Billings Avenue.
- Once in the building, follow the signs to the location of the event (Gym, Theater, etc.). Please also pay attention to the hallways that are blocked off and stay out of those areas.



Softball and Football Games

- For football games played at the practice field location, spectators are encouraged to park at the Harris Street Temporary School Parking Lot location and walk to the field area from there.
- For softball games, there is some limited parking available on Missoula Avenue and a few on Billings Avenue. Attendees will also be encouraged to park at the Harris Street Lot and walk over to the game from there.
- In all situations, spectators will need to be aware of areas designated for Emergency Parking and Bus Loading zones and not park in those areas.



Safety Precautions

- We recognize that Roberts Street, Billings Avenue, Harris Street, Townsend and Boulder Avenue will become busier with traffic during this process. While we realize that sometimes people run late and are pushing the speed limit to get to an event on time, please be aware that there will be an increase of students at crosswalks. Additionally, we will have more traffic in the areas around Bryant Elementary with many of those families continuing to walk to school and try to do safe drop offs of their children.

- Admin and staff will be at crosswalks, in the new parking lot area and at our bus stop area before and after school. Please pay attention and observe their commands as they help students cross streets safely and help keep things flowing efficiently.
