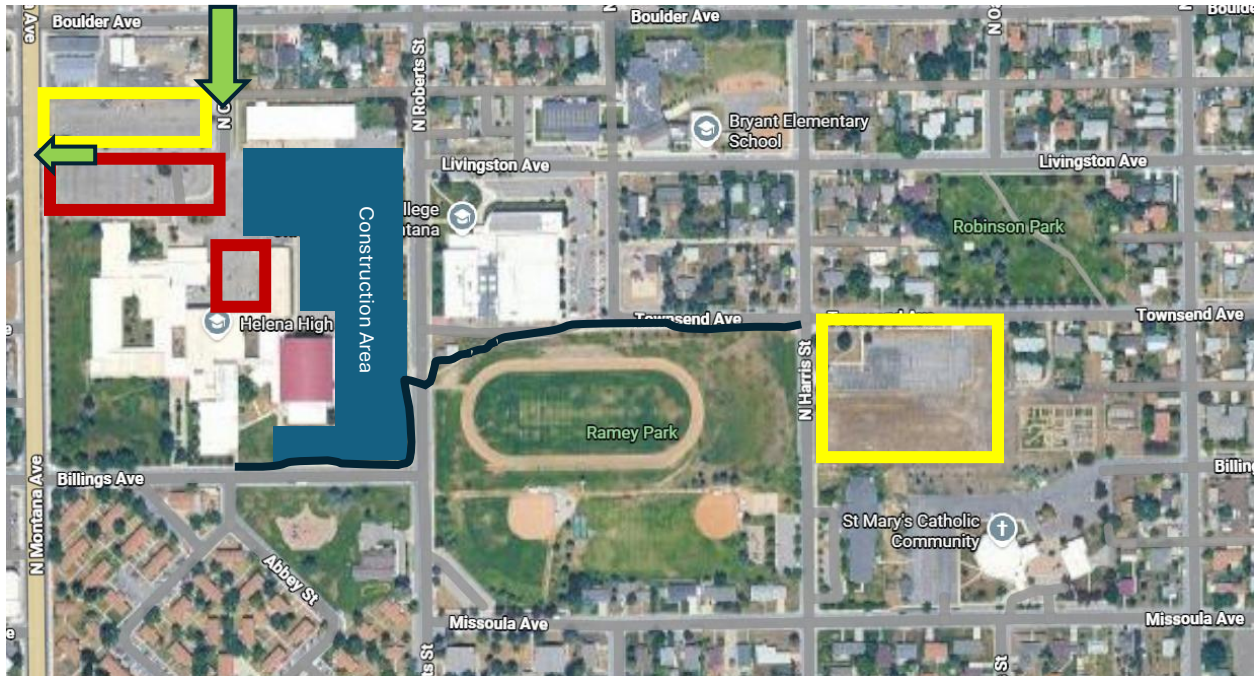


Student Parking, Drop Off/Pick Up, Bus Drop off/Pick Up, Entry into the Building Length – Majority of Construction

Student Parking

We will start with the big question on people's minds– student parking:

- As we work to be great neighbors during this process, we are going to ask that students refrain from parking in the various neighborhoods around the school, along with not parking in the lots of private businesses.
- There will be two main areas for students to park during construction – outlined in yellow on the image. We are working on a potential third area and will release that location if/when that plan is finalized.
 - For the parking lot area on campus, this will be a first-come, first-served parking area. Students will need to enter from Boulder Avenue. The Montana Avenue egress point will remain an exit only area (unless otherwise communicated). There will be no access to HHS from Roberts Street during construction.
 - For the parking lot area on the corner of Harris Street and Townsend Avenue, students will be able to enter both from Harris Street and Townsend Avenue. For those parking in this lot, we will run a shuttle bus to the school. The bus will leave from that lot at 8:05 a.m. Otherwise, students will need to walk to campus (path designated on the image below).
- Parking Permits will be required to park in our designated parking lots (on campus and at the Harris Street lot). These will be available for purchase through RevTrak for \$5 starting on the dates below until sold out. Students will be expected to have these on display in their vehicles as we have in the past. Students will be able to purchase parking permits on the following schedule:
 - Seniors – August 17
 - Juniors – August 18
 - Sophomores – August 19
 - Freshmen – August 20
- Staff parking lots will remain the same and are reserved for staff parking only during the school day. Visitor parking will still be available on the northeast side of the larger staff parking area.
- The area along Cooke Street (by the shops) has been designated for Emergency Vehicles and has been painted red, there will be no available parking there at this time.

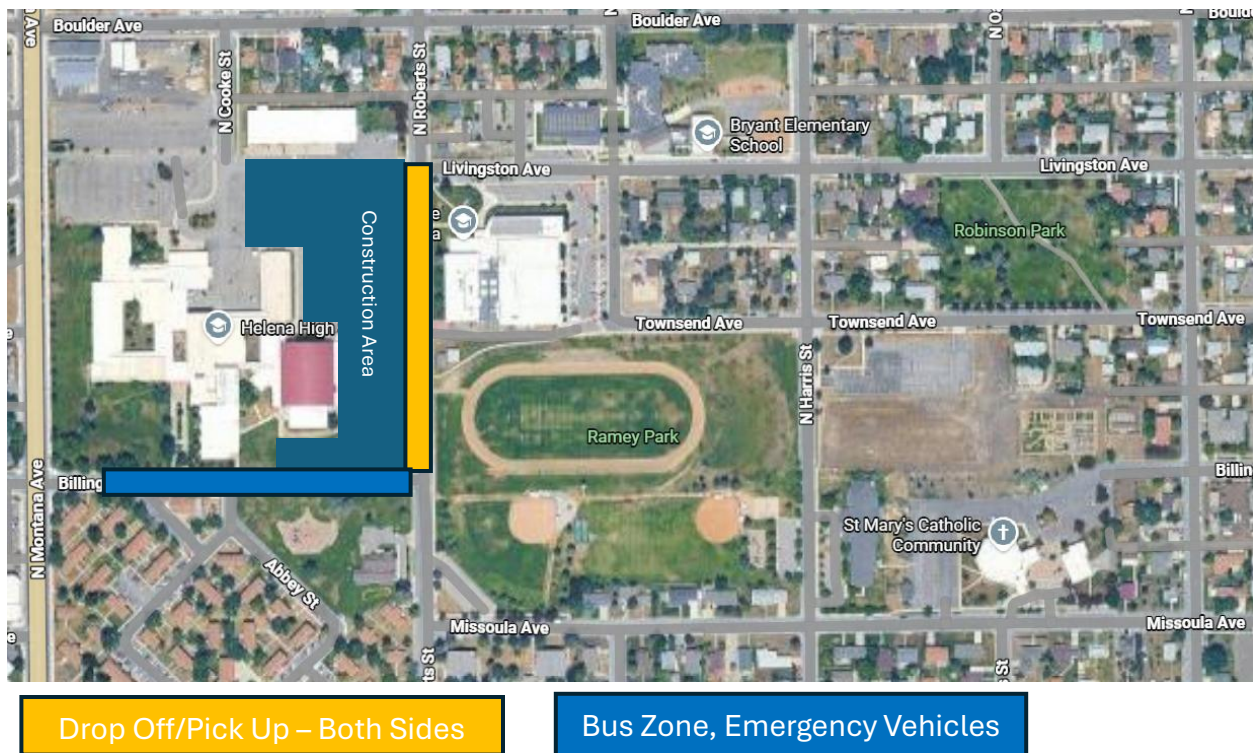
Staff Parking

➔ Entry and exit areas to the campus parking

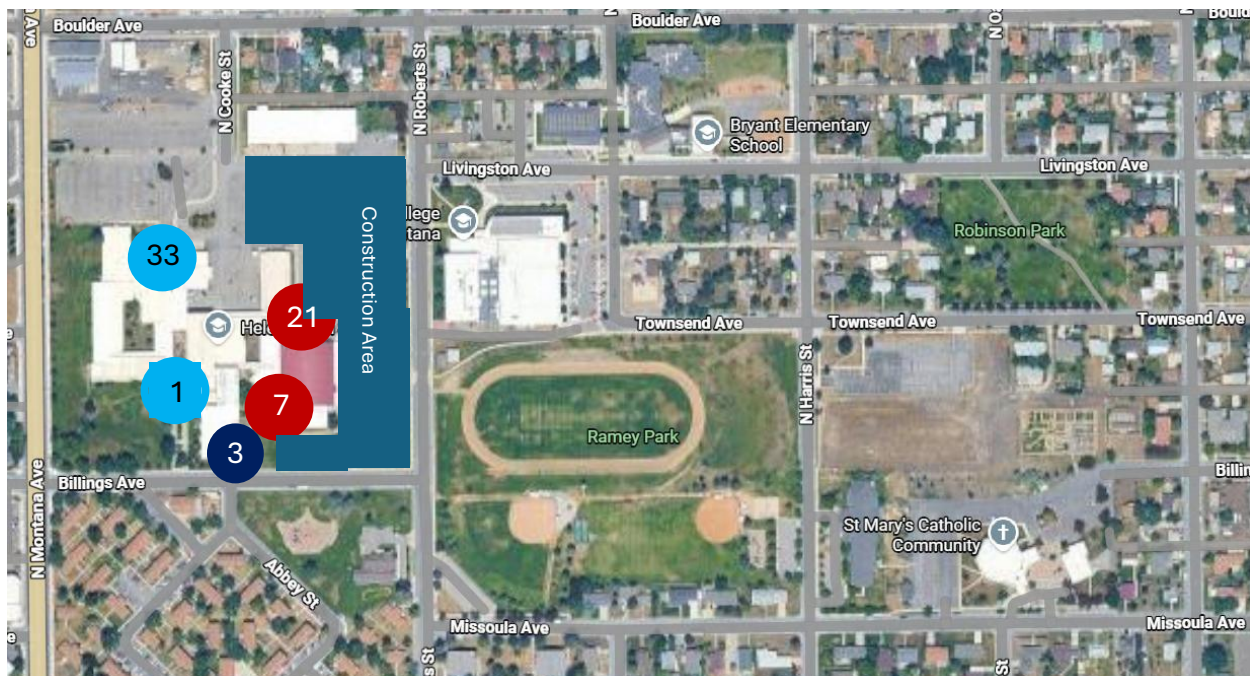
Parent Drop Off and Pick Up and Bus Area

- Parents will be asked to drop students off and pick them up along Roberts Street.
- The drop off circle will be utilized for certain bus drop offs and that area is anticipated to be more congested – our hope is to limit the traffic in that area as best we can with this plan.
- The South side of Billings Avenue (not the school side) may also have availability for pick-up and drop-off. The school side of Billings Avenue will be where our buses pick up and drop students off and will be needed for Emergency Vehicles.



Student Entry to the Building

- Entry 21, the entry where many would come in from the old Blue or Red Lots or for a game, will be Emergency Exit Only moving forward. No one will be able to come in those doors.
- Entry 1 (off Billings Avenue) and Entry 33 (by the Attendance Office) will be the main entry points for anything happening at the school.
- From 7:00-8:20 a.m., Entry 3 that leads into the upper science hallway will be open for students to use. Outside of those times, students will need to use Entry 1 or 33 (outlined below).



- Main Entries
- Emergency Exit Only
- Open 7-8:20 a.m. each morning for student entry

Safety Precautions

- We recognize that Roberts Street, Billings Avenue, Harris Street, Townsend and Boulder Avenue will become busier with traffic during this process. While we recognize that sometimes people are running late and are pushing the speed limit a little to get there on time, please be aware that there will be an increase in students at crosswalks, and we will have more traffic in the areas around Bryant Elementary with many of those families continuing to walk to school and try to do safe drop offs of their children.
- Admin and staff will be at crosswalks, in the new parking lot area and at our bus stop area before and after school. Please pay attention and observe their commands as they help students cross streets safely and help keep things flowing efficiently.
